

# Arkansas Specific Requirements

## Arkansas Requirements per Arkansas Regulations on Pesticide Use

<b>Nov. 1 – April 15</b>	Federal label must be followed
<b>April 16 – June 30</b> *These restrictions are in addition to the federal label.	<b>DO NOT APPLY IF:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• University or USDA Research Stations are within a 1 mile radius of application site</li><li>• Certified Organic Crops or Commercial Special Crop Production (1,000 plants or \$25,000) are within ½ mile radius of application site</li><li>• Non-dicamba tolerant crops (except corn and rice) are within ¼ mile radius of application site</li><li>• Glyphosate tankmixes prohibited</li></ul>
<b>Training Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must have Private, Commercial, or Non-Commercial Applicator License.</li><li>• Must have Dicamba Specific training from registrant.</li></ul>

\*Always read and follow label directions. Engenia®, Xtendimax®, and Tavium® herbicides are US EPA restricted use pesticides.

# Additional Arkansas Requirements

- **Soybean - DO NOT apply after June 30**
- **Cotton - DO NOT apply after June 30**
- **Arkansas requires maintaining spray records for 3 years.**



**Record must be made for each application of approve dicamba products**

# Record Keeping

## Additional Arkansas Requirements

1. Type of equipment used
2. Commercial Application Equipment Number
3. Maintain spray records for 3 years
