Michigan	- Commercial pesticide applicators are required to maintain records of restricted use pesticide applications for 3 years (Regulation 636, Rule 15(1)).
Nebraska	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Tank mix and nozzle information must be printed and with the applicator at time of application and attached to the spray records once the application is complete.▪ Records are to be completed at the end of each day.▪ Records must be kept for 3 years.▪ While not required, it is a best practice to be trained prior to purchase.
