## Specific State Regulatory Compliance Information

(Approved Dicamba Formulations)



- Any deviations from the product label requirements and all supplemental label/document requirements constitutes a violation of state statute or regulation.
- A violation of state statute or regulation may result in monetary penalties assessed to the violator.
- Applicators are required to check Bulletins Live! Two and follow any additional application restrictions. Counties requiring notice of endangered species when making dicamba applications include Barren, Bourbon, Bullitt, Fleming, Franklin, Hardin, Harrison, Henry, Jefferson, Meade, Nicholas, and Warren.

**DO NOT use dicamba if you are unwilling or unable to follow requirements**

- The Kentucky Department of Agriculture's Pesticide Inspectors will be conducting routine inspections of Private Applicators and Commercial Applicators to ensure compliance with these new label requirements.
- You must have your application records immediately available at the time of inspection. If you utilize an electronic record keeping system, you must be able to readily access these records. **Our recommendation is to complete the label's record keeping requirement after each application and keep these records on hand.**
