

# Training for Approved Dicamba Formulations

## Additional State Information:

### Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota

- Like most dicot plants, sugar beets are very sensitive to synthetic auxin herbicides.
- Product labels must be rigorously followed to prevent both drift to sensitive species and spray system contamination.



**DO NOT use dicamba if you are unwilling or unable to follow requirements**

<b>Michigan</b>	- <b>Commercial</b> pesticide applicators are required to maintain records of restricted use pesticide applications for <b>3 years</b> (Regulation 636, Rule 15(1)).
<b>Nebraska</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Tank mix and nozzle information must be printed and with the applicator at time of application and attached to the spray records once the application is complete.</li><li>▪ Records are to be completed at the end of each day.</li><li>▪ Records must be kept for 3 years.</li><li>▪ While not required, it is a best practice to be trained prior to purchase.</li></ul>
