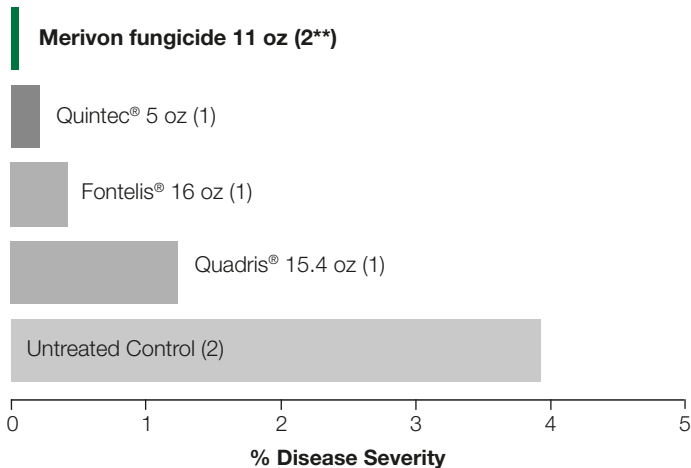

## Best Use Recommendations

- Use Rate: 7–11 oz/A
- Maximum applications: 3
- Begin applications prior to onset of disease and continue on a 7 to 14 day interval
- PHI: 1 day
- May be mixed with other products, such as insecticides
- For spinach only, DO NOT TANK MIX
- Adjuvant flexible

## Resistance Management
